# emsCharts Training

**Included in your contract with emsCharts** is four hours of standard training performed via a series of easy and convenient web meetings. Standard training is broken down as follows.

## Training I

This training will get you started. It includes the basics of configuration, how to enter a patient record, how to get your users configured and logged-in, and other general start-up information.

Training I is recommended for individuals who will be emsCharts Administrators. We recommend at least two people take part in this training.

Training I will take about 1.5 to 2 hours and should be scheduled as soon as possible once your company has purchased emsCharts.

## Training II

This stage of training focuses on the needs of the service. The trainer will spend time addressing your specific needs and questions. Additional modules covered include Billing and emsCharts Mobile.

Personnel that should attend this session will depend on what areas your service needs training. Consult your trainer prior to class to see who they recommend attend.

This session will take 1.5 to 2 hours also and may be broken into 2 sessions if needed. You should schedule this within a week of Training I

## Training III

This is our **GO Live** Kick Off which follows check list to be sure you are ready to go. All final questions will be cleaned up and the attendees will be ready to launch emsCharts live.

This session takes 0.5 to 1 hour. emsCharts administrators must be present.

# Online Training



All On-Line training sessions are performed using web conferencing software that we provide to you. This allows your trainer to share with you an application, a desktop, a presentation, or a white board—conveniently through an Internet connection. Your trainer will perform training demonstrations using your actual service database. Web training allows you to ask questions and actively participate as though you were in a classroom. To hold a web training you must have a computer with an Internet connection and an available telephone. We require a speaker phone if more than one person will be present. You may use a projector system if desired. As many personnel may attend training as you feel necessary. We ask that one person is designated as the “leader” on your end.

# On-site Training

Would like to have your training performed in your office by an emsCharts trainer? All on-site training must be arranged through your Salesman and/or the Training Manager.

While on-site, the trainer will be available to you for 8 hours per day (typically, on-site training will be a minimum of 2 days). Each day may be broken up into sessions to accommodate multiple groups. All details and requests should be worked out prior to contracting the training. Charges will be billed with your initial setup fee or next monthly bill.

Your emsCharts sales rep can help you determine the number of days your service may require, as well as the cost per day. If all crew are to be trained then a longer time period will be required for all shifts.
